## DUTTON RANCHES PINOT NOIR

**VINEYARD** Dutton Ranches Pinot Noir comes from the Dutton Lorenzo vineyard in the Green Valley, a cool climate area just south of Forestville, CA in the Russian River Valley AVA. The vines grow in the fabled Goldridge sandy loam, common to this area.

**STYLE** This inaugural vintage of Dutton Ranches Pinot Noir showcases the briary fruit tones and higher acidity from grapes grown in a cooler area of the Russian River Valley. The Dijon clones 667 and 115 dominate the fruit profile while the Pommard clone adds a silky texture to the mid-palate and finish. A dose of new French oak provides complexity and balance to the fruit and acidity of the grapes.

**FOOD PAIRING** Savor this wine with goat cheese crostini topped with wild mushrooms, rosemary crusted lamb shanks or your favorite sharp cheese.
